

Application for Board of Directors - Due January 31, 2018

The Limelight Ketchum Community Fund is dedicated to serving the Wood River Valley's neediest individuals and families by providing grants to health and human service organizations. These grants could support early childhood education and youth development, help neighbors in crisis or who are struggling with mental health, and ensure those affected by domestic abuse have what they need to feel protected and be able to rebuild. In 2017 the board chose to focus funding on mental health, domestic abuse, education, and organizations whose work addresses those in crisis (emotional, physical or otherwise).

Time commitment per year:

- Maximum of 4 site visits or conversations w/ grantees annually (1.5 hrs each)
- Maximum of 2 organizational meetings annually (1.5 hrs each)
- Two to four grant reviews (3-5 hrs each)
- One grant meeting (3 hrs)

All Limelight Ketchum employees who are donors to the Limelight Ketchum Community Fund are eligible to serve on the board. Directors are selected based on relevant skills and experience as well as their ability to recruit new members. The board tries to maintain diverse representation from all Limelight Ketchum departments.

There are two openings on the board. Board members will be elected to serve 3-year terms. The selection process will be very competitive.
